Each curve represents a climatic division of Texas. The curve marked HP is for the High Plains; TP is Trans-Pecos; LR, Low Rolling Plains; SD, Southern Division; LV, Lower Rio Grande Valley; EP, Edwards Plateau; NC, North Central; SC, South Central; UC, Upper Coast; and ET, East Texas. Curve values are based on U.S. Weather Bureau published data for the 30-year period 1931-60. Note the two maximum months, May and September, and the minimum period, November-March in all divisions but Trans-Pecos, High Plains, East Texas, and the Upper Coast.
