ADDENDUM 1: QUESTIONS / RESPONSES

Questions / Responses:

Question:

“Can an entity submit more than one application?”

Response to Question:

An entity may submit more than one application. There is no limit to the number of applications that can be submitted by an eligible applicant.

Question:

“Is there a limit to the amount requested?”

Response to Question:

There is no budget limit, but historically grantees have been funded \$100,000-\$250,000. Applicants can be partially funded as well.

Question:

“Is match funding required?”

Response to Question:

There is not a hard requirement for matching funds for this 2022 cycle. However, local matching can make your application more competitive amongst other applications. If there are any partners in the region that can provide local match or in-kind contributions to the proposed project, bringing them in could bolster the application.

Question:

“Is this grant for water districts or individual ranchers and farmers?”

Response to Question:

The Agricultural Water Conservation Grants Program provides funding to political subdivisions, state agencies, and state university systems. Applicants are encouraged to involve and engage participation from farmers and ranchers in their proposed projects. Examples include equipment cost-share programs with agricultural producers within a participating water district.
