



# Public Comment Period for Texas Water Fund – Water Loss Mitigation Project Prioritization

## **Comments due August 5**

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is holding a period of public review and comment of the [prioritization lists](#) of water loss mitigation projects to be funded through the Rural Water Assistance Fund and Water Loan Assistance Fund using funding from the Texas Water Fund.

In 2023, the 88th Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill (SB) 28 and Senate Joint Resolution (SJR) 75 providing for the creation of the Texas Water Fund. In addition, SB 30 authorized a one-time, \$1 billion supplemental appropriation of general revenue to the Texas Water Fund, contingent on enactment of SB 28 and approval of SJR 75 by voters. Proposition 6 (the proposition for SJR 75), creating the Texas Water Fund to assist in financing water projects in Texas, passed on November 7, 2023, with more than 77 percent in favor.

One of the key priorities of the Texas Water Fund is to use the funding for projects which address water loss. The TWDB is proposing to use the Rural Water Assistance Fund and Water Loan Assistance Fund to offer funding to projects which submitted project information forms for the State Fiscal Year 2025 (SFY25) Drinking Water (DWSRF) and Clean Water (CWSRF) State Revolving Funds, which address water loss.

The prioritization lists covered in this public comment period, which include projects that submitted a project information form for the SFY 2025 DWSRF and CWSRF Intended Use Plans, can be found on the [TWDB website](#).
