Dear New Regional Flood Planning Group Member,

Welcome to the second cycle of Texas' regional flood planning process created in 2019 by the Texas Legislature through Senate Bill 8. Over the next five years, your planning group will be responsible for adopting the second regional flood plan no later than January 10, 2028, and every five years thereafter. The second State Flood Plan, to be developed by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) based on the adopted regional plans, will be due September 1, 2029, and every five years thereafter.

The overarching goal of regional and state flood planning is to **protect against loss of life and property from flooding**. The TWDB staff look forward to working with you throughout this important and unprecedented process.

This opportunity for you and your fellow members to participate in regional flood planning comes with certain responsibilities. Planning group members are expected to:

- regularly attend their Regional Flood Planning Group (RPFG) meetings;
- understand and follow the flood planning framework, rules, bylaws, guidelines, and process, as well as review the various materials that will be considered by the planning group along the way;
- represent their interest categories in the regional flood planning process,
- solicit and consider public input;
- deliver a flood plan that serves the entire region and take into consideration the flood- related needs of all interests in the region, including flood plans developed by local entities;
- make significant decisions and recommendations regarding flood management goals, evaluations, strategies, and flood mitigation projects for their region; and
- ensure adoption of a regional flood plan that meets all requirements by the statutory deadline.

The TWDB is the agency designated by the legislature to provide technical and financial assistance to the regional flood planning process. Each RFPG has an assigned TWDB staff member to serve as a non-voting member of the RFPG and who will act as a liaison between the agency and the planning group.
