


Unpacking the LVWD ASR report ArcPro package

Follow these steps to unpack (extract) the ArcPro files for the LVWD ASR study and open the “.aprx” file:


- Open a new ArcPro project file
- From the “Analysis” tab, in the “Geoprocessing” group, select “Tools”
- In the “Find Tools” field, look for “Extract Package” tool and open it. Or you can find it in the “Data Management Tools” toolbox under “Package”.
- In the “Input Package” field, navigate to the folder containing the “.ppkx” package file and select it.
- Navigate to the desired folder to save the extracted package and select it for “Output Folder”
- Run the tool
- Results:




- Navigate to the folder with the .aprx files of your ArcPro version to open it.

Note, if you unpack the “.ppkx” package file by double clicking it, it may extract to a folder in your C drive (C:\Users\”USER NAME”\Documents\ArcGIS\Packages). To change the default package extraction location, you may change the following setting:

- Open ArcPro project settings > Options > Share and Download > Unpacking



You'll be able to set either a default location to unpack all packages or set up the option to prompt user before unpacking.
