

-  North Plains Ground Water Conservation District No. 2 (1954)
-  Panhandle Ground Water Conservation District No. 3 (1955)

-  Plateau Underground Water Conservation and Supply District (1965)

Frio County added to district in October 1985 after election following passage of SB-1253

-  Irion County Water Conservation District (1985)  
Southeast portion of district also included in Plateau district as shown in No. 8.
-  Martin County Underground Water Conservation District (1985)

-  Coke County Underground Water Conservation District (1986)
-  Sutton County Underground Water Conservation District (1986)  
Northwest portion of district also included in Plateau district as shown in No. 8. A small area in the northcentral part of the county was omitted from district
