Please find enclosed five copies of a grant application proposal and an electronic version to secure funding for development of the 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan. The funding requested will cover the next two years of the upcoming planning cycle.

The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group has worked diligently in developing the scope of work for preparation of its 2011 Regional Water Plan. The enclosed application and associated scope of work were developed in accordance with Texas Water Development Board guidance.

The tasks identified in this scope of work include a base funding budget of \$81,900, and a competitive funding budget of \$912,300, of which \$47,300 has been identified to be contributed by local participants (Cities of Waco and Sweetwater). This budget also reflects the fact that current planning efforts by the Johnson County SUD reduce needed study funds by an additional \$15,000. These funds are an in-kind contribution and are not reflected in the overall planning budget. This local participation reduces the necessary TWDB funding by a total of \$62,300. A priority ranking has been assigned to each task included in the competitive funding request.

8. Total proposed planning cost

The total proposed cost for this funding cycle is \$994,200. This figure does not include non-reimbursable administrative expenses associated with developing the plan. The Brazos River Authority has committed to paying the non-reimbursable administrative expenses through Fiscal Year 2007.

9. Cash Contribution to the Study

\$47,300 from the Cities of Waco and Sweetwater

10. List source of cash contribution, explanation of source of local cash contribution

City of Sweetwater - \$27,300 – The City of Sweetwater has committed these funds to offset costs for the Nolan County groundwater study, Priority Task Item No. 2.

City of Waco - \$20,000 – The City of Waco has indicated that it will commit these funds to offset costs for the Johnson-McLennan Counties study, Priority Task Item No. 5.

Johnson County SUD – in-kind contribution of \$15,000 – The Johnson County SUD is currently funding studies that will provide information that will be used to support Priority Task Item No. 5. This will offset funding required from the TWDB by \$15,000. This amount has already been removed from the planning grant budget for this task.

11. Total grant funds requested from the Texas Water Development Board

\$946,900 is requested through this grant application. This includes \$81,900 identified as base administrative funds and an additional \$865,000 of competitively based funds for prioritized scope of work tasks.

12. Detailed statement of the purpose for which the money will be used

Funding obtained through this application will be used to develop information that will be used in subsequent funding cycles to revise the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan to form the 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan. The regional water planning grant funds hereby requested will be used for reimbursement of expenses associated with general administrative and public participation activities including development of the scope of work contained herein, costs associated with public information (meeting notices, planning group member travel, mailings, maintenance of the Brazos G website, etc.), and 11 Prioritized Scope of Work Tasks recommended and prioritized at the August 9, 2006 meeting of the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group. These expenses include contractual services of the Subconsultant team led by HDR Engineering, Inc., the selection of which was reconfirmed at the August 9, 2006 meeting.

Cash contributions by the Cities of Waco and Sweetwater will be used to offset some of the state funding required. In-kind contributions by the Brazos River Authority and possibly others will be used to fund direct expenses required for administration of the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group. The direct expenses contributed by the Brazos River Authority include: salaries, benefits, travel, and other expenses (printing costs, costs for publication and mailing of notices which exceed the funding provided by the state, phone and long distance charges, office supplies, rental of facilities for public meetings, etc.).

13. Detailed description of why state funding assistance is needed

The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group has no legal authority to enter into contracts nor any means to generate revenues. Therefore, the Group is relying on grant funds from the State to perform the required task of revising the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan to form the 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan.

14. Identify potential sources and amounts of funding available for implementation of viable solutions resulting from proposed planning

Due to the vast scale of this planning effort, there are a number of potential funding sources that may be used to implement recommended water management strategies identified for various water user groups and wholesale water providers. These include, but are not limited to, private funding sources, state and federal loan/grant programs, and the open market.

20. Specific deliverables for each task in Scope of Work

The results of work of each task will be presented to the Regional Water Planning Group at regularly scheduled planning group meetings for review. Draft reports or summary memorandums (as appropriate to the subject will be provided to the Planning Group for review. Appropriate changes and/or corrections will be made, and final report(s) will be submitted to the planning group and the TWDB. Specific deliverables are identified in the individual task scopes.

21. Method of monitoring study progress

The Brazos River Authority will provide administrative functions in support of all activities, including contract administration, subconsultant contract management and oversight, meeting preparation and management, posting of meeting notices, meeting attendance, and public participation activities.

The Primary Subconsultant will provide updates at the RWPG meetings of the work being performed to revise the regional water plan, and will be a part of the monthly requests for reimbursement from TWDB. Draft and final reports will be required of the Primary Subconsultant, and transmitted to TWDB, in accordance with planning contract procedures and requirements.

22. Qualifications and direct experience of proposed project staff

The Brazos River Authority, the administrative agent for the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group, will be responsible for management of the project. The Brazos River Authority has served in this same capacity during development of the 2001 and 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plans. HDR Engineering, Inc. has been selected by the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group as the lead technical consultant for developing the 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan. HDR served in this same capacity during development of the 2001 and 2006 Brazos G Plans. HDR is also the lead technical consultant for Regions L, N, and O during development of the 2001 and 2006 plans. To develop the 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan, HDR will continue to team with Freese and Nichols, Inc., R. W. Harden & Associates, Hicks and Company, and Fletcher Communications.

III. WRITTEN ASSURANCES

The proposed planning activities by the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group do not duplicate existing projects. Efforts have been taken to identify current initiatives related to this scope of work and to coordinate with entities pursuing those efforts so as to not duplicate existing work, but to provide a vehicle to further leverage local, regional, and state funds.

- (2) mailing notice to each mayor of a municipality with a population of 1,000 or more or which is a county seat and that is located in whole or in part in the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Area, to each county judge of a county located in whole or in part in the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Area, to all districts and authorities created under Texas Constitution, Article III, §52, or Article XVI, §59, located in whole or in part in the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Area based upon lists of such water districts and river authorities obtained from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and all regional water planning groups in the state.

The following potential scope of work tasks were adopted at the August 9, 2006 Brazos G RWPG meeting. The tasks are consolidated from individual ideas identified and discussed at the July 12, 2006 Scope of Work Committee meeting, and further consolidated at the July 23, 2006 Scope of Work Committee meeting. The tasks are listed in priority order.

Administration

Budget: \$81,900.

Administration of Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group activities, including scope of work development, meetings related to scope of work, public participation and outreach, public notices and mailings, planning group member travel, regular and specially-called planning group and committee meetings, and expenses related to the Brazos G website.

Task 1. Impact of drought on reservoir water supplies in the upper Brazos G area

Budget: \$79,900.

Scope: The ongoing drought has reduced supplies from reservoirs in the upper Brazos G area significantly. An updated drought of record analysis was completed for the 2006 Plan, but only utilized data available through June 2004. Continuation of the drought in West Texas since 2004 has likely reduced supplies further. For example, the available supply from O.H. Ivey Reservoir has been reduced by 28% of its originally estimated yield, but the 2006 Brazos G Plan only recognizes a 15% reduction. This work item will extend the naturalized flow record for the applicable upper-basin control points in the Brazos WAM through June 2008 to evaluate if supplies have been further reduced since June 2004. In addition, multiple reservoirs in the upper Brazos G area are experiencing extremely low levels, which could affect water quality from the remaining supply. Correlations between water quality constituents and reservoir level will be developed for up to three selected reservoirs in the western portion of the region with sufficient available data, in order to determine the level of degradation in water quality that occurs at lower lake levels. The implications of any degradation of water quality during drought with regard to the usability of the water supply from the reservoirs will be discussed and applied to other reservoirs in the region.

Task 1A. Updated Drought Analysis. Update naturalized flows at selected primary control points in the Upper Brazos River Basin and compute firm and safe yields at reservoirs used for water supply.

Task 1B. Water Quality Impacts of Drought. Collect reservoir water quality data from existing databases (USGS, USEPA, TCEQ, local reservoir owners) for three reservoirs in the western portion of the Brazos G Area, analyze data for relationships between reservoir level and water quality, extrapolate those relationships to other reservoirs in the western Brazos G Area, and

determine the effects of low reservoir levels on water quality and water quality impacts on useable supplies from those reservoirs.

Task 1C. Report/Meetings. Prepare final summary memorandums and report findings at up to two Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group meetings.

Deliverables: 1. Memorandum documenting updated flows and reservoir yields due to drought
2. Memorandum documenting water quality analyses and effect on supplies
3. Presentation of findings to Brazos G RWPG

Task 2. Re-evaluate water management strategies for the Nolan County area

Budget:	TWDB Funding Requested:	\$78,200.

Scope: A recommended water supply strategy for the City of Sweetwater and several customers is a groundwater supply from the Champion Well Field in Nolan County. This well field overlies the Edwards-Trinity Aquifer but draws water from the Edwards-Trinity and Dockum Aquifers. The current "Groundwater Availability Model for the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) and Cenozoic Pecos Alluvium Aquifer System, Texas" has been completed, and a groundwater availability model of the Dockum Aquifer is in progress. These models are regional in scale, which makes them of limited value for well field studies and evaluations. As a result, a local scale groundwater model will be developed and used as a tool to evaluate groundwater supplies from well field(s) in south-central Nolan County. The local scale model will be centered on the existing Champion Well Field and extend several miles beyond potential well field expansion areas. This will include some areas where aquifers other than the Edwards-Trinity Aquifer exist. To the extent possible, information from TWDB's GAMs will be used to delineate the aquifer's framework and estimate recharge and background pumping. Pumping and water level data from the Champion Well Field and other data will be used for model calibration. After development, the model will be used to estimate the long-term supply of water from the Champion Well Field and its potential as a long-term water management strategy for the City of Sweetwater in the Regional Water Plan. The long-term evaluation will also consider water quality. Alternative well field operations will be identified and investigated to prolong and/or increase existing groundwater supplies. If revised estimates of long-term supplies from the well field are shown to be less than assumed in 2006, the water management strategies for Sweetwater and Nolan County will be reevaluated. Alternative strategies include 1. supply from City of Abilene, 2. other groundwater, 3. smaller configuration or off-channel alternative to Double Mountain Fork Reservoir, 4. scalping operation into Lake Sweetwater.

Task 2A. Update Groundwater Supplies Available from the Champion Well Field. Develop localized model of the Edwards-Trinity and Dockum formations in the vicinity of the Champion Well Field in Nolan County. Calibrate the model to pumping data and observed water levels. Estimate long-term supplies available from the well field and identify operational strategies to prolong the well field life. Report and coordinate with the City of Sweetwater and other affected Nolan County entities.

Task 2B. Evaluate Alternative Water Management Strategies for the Nolan County Area. Identify and evaluate alternative strategies to increase supplies in the Nolan County Area. Potential alternative strategies identified include 1. supply from City of Abilene, 2. other groundwater, 3.

smaller configuration or off-channel alternative to Double Mountain Fork Reservoir, 4. scalping operation into Lake Sweetwater.

Task 3. Regionalization strategies to assist small water systems in meeting new SDWA requirements

Scope: Rules adopted for public water systems subsequent to passage of the 1996 amendments to the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) include new requirements related to higher levels of treatment that can be difficult for small water systems to attain. Financial and personnel training/certification considerations limit the extents to which many smaller systems can comply with the requirements. However, if smaller systems within a localized area were able to share resources (trained personnel and treatment facilities), these stricter standards might be more readily attained by each participating utility. This task will identify specific utilities in locations where regionalization could allow multiple small utilities to share resources and reduce individual treatment and personnel costs. In addition, larger water user groups will be identified that might become or participate as regional suppliers. Two (2) potential regional systems will be identified, and the engineering and financial considerations for forming the regional partnerships will be developed and summarized. The specific utilities involved will be contacted, and their interest will be documented.

Task 3A. Evaluate Two Regional Systems. Identify two opportunities for regionalization of water systems, and evaluate the engineering, financial, and other considerations required for regionalization.

Task 3B. Report/Meetings. Prepare final summary report and report findings at a Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group meeting.

Budget: \$74,900., distributed as follows:

- Task 4C. Changes due to Trans-Texas Corridor: \$12,400.
- Task 4D. Alternative Water Demands for Slow-Growth Counties: \$12,700.

Scope: Certain counties or water user groups are experiencing growth rates significantly greater than projected from the 1990 and 2000 Census. **Evaluate revised population growth rates, focusing on years 2010, 2020 and 2030, to determine if the implementation of recommended water management strategies needs to be accelerated, and if additional strategies are needed.** Revise population and water demand projections for counties along the SH130 corridor (Williamson) and Trans-Texas transportation corridor (RCA5 – Williamson, Bell, Falls, McLennan, Limestone, and Hill), as implementation of those two projects will foster increased economic and population growth in those areas. Coordinate with Regions K, L, and C concerning appropriate assessments of the effects of SH130 and the Trans-Texas corridors. In addition, entities in West Texas have relatively low growth projections, primarily due to economic conditions which stalled growth between 1990 and 2000. Those entities wish to plan for water supplies sufficient to meet desired growth in order to attract new industry and stimulate renewed growth. Develop alternative water demand projections for water user groups in urban areas that have relatively flat population projections, to ensure that additional supply is available to serve desired economic growth, both from desired population growth as well as new industry.

Task 5. Refine water management strategies for Johnson and McLennan County areas

Task 5A- Update water management strategies for Johnson County

Johnson County is experiencing rapid growth from the north, and has large projected water needs. Nearby areas in Region C including southwest Dallas, northwest Ellis, and southeast Tarrant Counties are experiencing similar high growth patterns. As current water supplies become inadequate to meet future water needs and the area becomes more developed, a regional water supply system becomes increasingly attractive.

The Johnson County SUD has commissioned some recent and ongoing studies related to evaluating future water supplies, which will provide some significant information that could be used

by the Brazos G and Region C RWPGs. This has reduced the necessary TWDB funding by approximately \$15,000.

All work items associated with this task require interregional coordination with Region C. The budget includes work items related to Brazos G water user groups and does not duplicate work items included in the Region C scope. Brazos G work items will be related to Johnson County water users and work efforts coordinated with Region C for potential water supply participants in Dallas, Ellis, and Tarrant Counties.

Scope:

- Consider the following recent studies for water supply in the area since the 2006 Brazos G Plan, including:
 - Johnson County Special Utility District – JCSUD is in the process of completing their Trinity River Basin Water Supply Study, which includes evaluating treated and raw water supplies from the Trinity River Basin to meet a part of its future water supply needs. The results of the study will need to be incorporated in the water supply plan for Johnson County Special Utility District.
 - City of Joshua and Johnson County FWSD No.1 – In late 2005, the City of Joshua provided a letter of consent to proceed with merging Johnson County FWSD No. 1 with Johnson County Special Utility District. After receiving unanimous public support for the merger, an application was filed with approval anticipated by end of 2006. Changes in wholesale water provider (and water supply) based on the merger will need to be considered during the next planning cycle.
 - The City of Arlington is conducting a wholesale water rate study to include evaluating water supply arrangements with Johnson County water users.
 - The Brazos River Authority and Tarrant Regional Water District conducted a "Regional Water Supply and Wastewater Service Study for Johnson and Parker Counties" in April 2004 and identified several water delivery scenarios that could provide water supplies to Johnson and Parker County water users. Contingent on interest by Johnson County water users identified in the study, possible work items could include continuation of the study leading to project implementation.
- Meet with study area water suppliers interested in a regional water supply system and Region C representatives to discuss water supply for Johnson County water user groups in the 2006 Brazos G Water Plan, population and water use projections, existing water system infrastructure, current plans to provide future water supplies, possible sources of supply, and discuss potential participant's roles in the regional water supply system. Brazos G potential participants include Mansfield, Alvarado, and Johnson County Special Utility District (including Johnson County Fresh and Joshua after merger).
- Assimilate results of the meetings and participate in discussions with water suppliers in the area such as Trinity River Authority, Brazos River Authority, and Tarrant Regional Water District. Discuss Johnson County trends in the study area, currently available supplies, discuss potential role in developing additional supplies, and timeline of new projects and infrastructure improvements.
- Review population and demand projections through 2030 considering 2006 Brazos G Water Plan projections, North Central Texas Council of Government traffic survey zone projections, and other projections from individual water providers in the study area. Coordinate this effort with Region C. Region C will prepare technical memorandum

identifying range of possible projections for study area and provide to water suppliers in the study area, TRA, BRA, and TRWD for review and comment.

- Participate with Region C in developing up to 6 conceptual alternatives to supply water to the study area, which may include regional water treatment plant with raw water supplied from Lake Joe Pool, Brazos River Authority, or Tarrant Regional Water District. Identify short-term treated water options, as necessary. Present to Brazos G RWPG for comment.
- Present conceptual plans to area water suppliers and participate in meeting to identify four plans for detailed analysis. Meet with Brazos G RWPG to discuss four plans identified, receive comments, and provide comments to Region C.
- Assist Region C in the detailed study of four selected alternative water supply approaches, including associated planning-level capital and operating costs.
- Participate in workshop with area water suppliers and other entities to discuss draft results of the analysis and the recommended plan.
- Provide technical support to Region C as they prepare a draft report summarizing recommendations for water management strategies for the study area, which will be provided to Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group and TWDB for review and comment. The report will be revised as appropriate and finalized.

Deliverables: 1. Summary report documenting the findings of the regional water supply system study, including up to four regional water supply system options (interregional coordination with Region C).
2. Three meetings with Brazos G RWPG during regional water supply study development, including meeting to present final study results.

Task 5B- Update water management strategies for McLennan County

In McLennan County, the City of Waco has been identified as the primary regional provider. However, Waco supplies are limited and would be virtually fully utilized by Year 2060. Explore additional water management strategies for the City, and identify water management strategies for specific water user groups in McLennan County that will serve as alternatives to receiving supply from the City of Waco. This task includes coordination with the City of Waco and surrounding communities to identify preferred water management strategies, and evaluation of the capability of those strategies to replace current or contemplated supplies from the City of Waco. The City of Waco has expressed an interest in participating in the funding of this task and could provide \$20,000, which would reduce the necessary TWDB funding accordingly.

Task 6. Updated evaluation of sources and control of chloride pollution

Budget: \$148,700.

Scope: Identify and quantify current sources of elevated chlorides in the Brazos River, and identify future sources such as increased brine disposal from RO treatment. Prepare a basin-wide salinity mass balance using recently-implemented features in WRAP to model salinity under the Brazos G assumptions and implementation of the recommended water plan. Include the effects of secondary recovery by oilfields, such as is occurring in Hubbard Creek Reservoir, and possibly occurring in Possum Kingdom, and Granbury Reservoirs. Use the analysis to identify the effects of salinity on water supplies for municipal, irrigation, and some industrial uses. Perform further evaluations of upper basin chloride control projects to improve water quality, including the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's current project. Consider the impacts of chloride reduction on endangered/threatened species dependant on saline surface water. Also perform feasibility-level study of measures to control seepage into reservoirs from secondary recovery operations.

Task 6A. Chloride Mass Balance and Effects. Collect and summarize available chloride data, quantify the effects of secondary recovery operations based on available data and evidence, perform a salt balance simulation using the salt version of the Brazos WAM, and quantify the effects of salinity on water supplies (cost, usability of water, etc.).

Task 6B. Strategies for Chloride Control. Evaluate strategies for chloride control, including the existing BUREC project in the area of Garza, Kent, and Stonewall Counties, and evaluate the feasibility of controlling chloride from secondary recovery seeping into reservoirs. Evaluate the effects of chloride control on threatened and endangered species potentially dependant on saline water.

Task 6C. Report/RWPG Meetings. Prepare final summary report and report findings at a Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group meeting.

Task 7. Participate in HB1763 process to assist GMA's in establishing desired future conditions

Scope: The GMA process required under HB1763 could significantly impact available groundwater supplies in Brazos G. For the 2011 Plan, groundwater availability estimates established by the GMAs and are to be used by the regional water planning groups. The regional water planning groups, in particular Brazos G, have spent considerable time and effort in developing reasonable groundwater availability estimates and should be involved in the GMA process in order to advise the GMAs on previous technical analyses developed by the regional plans and the likely outcomes and ramifications resulting from decisions considered by the GMAs. No technical analyses (groundwater modeling) will be developed under this task. The Brazos G RWPG will direct their technical consultant to attend and participate in the GMA process, report back to the RWPG, and communicate feedback between the GMA process and the Brazos G RWPG. The Brazos G technical consultant will attend and participate in up to 15 meetings related to GMA activities during this important coordination process.

Task 7A. GMA Meetings. Attend and participate in up to 7 GMA meetings.

Task 7B. RWPG Meetings. Attend and Report at up to 3 Brazos G RWPG Meetings.

Identify 4 tributary areas in need of additional supply for which it is plausible that main stem supplies could be used to augment the tributary supplies. Determine water available to supplement those supplies and develop planning-level cost estimates for the projects.

Task 10. Impacts of stock tanks and small ponds on reservoir yields

Budget: \$48,100.

Scope: A trend has been identified where historically large, undivided tracts of rangeland are being subdivided into smaller tracts or ranchettes, with multiple owners. These new owners are allowed to construct stock tanks and small ponds up to 200 acre-feet in capacity without acquiring water rights from the State. These tanks and ponds impound runoff from watersheds that would ordinarily fill downstream reservoirs. Reduced runoff from a reservoir watershed will decrease reservoir yields and dependable supplies. While any single tank or pond is unlikely to have a noticeable effect on runoff from a reservoir's watershed, the cumulative effect of multiple ponds could be large. For a moderately-sized watershed above a major reservoir, use historical mapping, historical aerial photography, and satellite imagery to identify changes in the numbers of tanks and ponds over time. Estimate cumulative surface acreages and cumulative storage volumes (if reasonable to do so), and evaluate the effects of these facilities on watershed runoff and downstream reservoir yields.

Task 10A. Data Collection and Analysis. Identify reservoir watershed to study, develop digital data from historical mapping, aerial photograph, and satellite imagery, summarize historical data, and quantify the effects of small pond proliferation on storage, flows and evaporation.

Task 10B. Yield Effects. Evaluate the effects of stock pond proliferation on the yield of the selected reservoir.

Task 11. Water quality aspects of indirect reuse as a water management strategy

Budget: \$107,400.

Scope: Introduction of reuse water into water supply reservoirs to increase yields may result in some undesirable effects on water quality, including the introduction of endocrine disruptors from pharmaceuticals, and increases in total dissolved solids (TDS), nutrients, and others. Evaluate recent literature on the subject, and perform an analysis (mass balance and fate/transport) using water samples obtained from a potential indirect reuse project, such as the Clear Fork Scalping project into Hubbard Creek Reservoir. Describe barriers to implementation of reuse as a water supply.

11A. Data Collection and Analysis. Perform literature review to summarize important WQ issues with regard to indirect reuse and water planning, collect and summarize water quality data, and describe WQ barriers to implantation of reuse as a water supply.

11B. Fate and Transport Analysis. Perform a fate and transport/mass balance analysis on a reservoir for which indirect reuse is considered, such as the Clear Fork Scalping into Hubbard Creek Reservoir.

11C. Report/RWPG Meerings. Prepare final summary memorandum and report findings at a Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group meeting.

Mr. Dunn's background is in water resources engineering, water supply planning, hydrology, fluvial geomorphology, and statistical data analysis. His project experience includes analysis of hydrologic and hydraulic systems, riverine sediment transport, reservoir system and river basin modeling and analysis, flood-frequency analysis, statistical analysis of water-quality and streamflow data, and analysis and design of municipal water distribution systems. Mr. Dunn is well-versed in the collection and analysis of hydrologic data and in the application and development of water resources computer models. He has served as an instructor at the National Training Center of the U.S. Geological Survey.

The data collection included the use of a high-resolution, real-time, kinematic global positioning system, and an acoustic doppler current profiler. Velocity vectors were mapped, and bed-material was sampled, upstream and through the mined reach. Analyzed the data to determine the localized effects of the mining operation on sand-transport and flow hydraulics. The final report from this project was published as USGS WRIR 01-4057.

Mr. Land has over 37 years experience as a water resources engineer. His career includes over 30 years of experience with the U.S. Geological Survey-Water Resource Division. He has worked in the fields of ground water, surface water, and water quality. Mr. Land's greatest interests are solving water supply problems and issues and bringing all the disciplines of hydrology together for a comprehensive, technical assessment. His activities with HDR have been in water-resource planning, development, monitoring, well design, well field evaluation, and conjunctive use of surface water and ground water.

HDR Project Experience

Determination of Brackish Groundwater Supplies in the vicinity of Corpus Christi.

Project Manager. One of the alternative water supplies for the City of Corpus Christi is desalination of local surface water (Gulf of Mexico) and groundwater (Gulf Coast Aquifer). To assess the feasibility of developing brackish groundwater, Mr. Land developed a groundwater model of the major water bearing zone of the Gulf Coast Aquifer in Nueces County. He tested three potential well field locations and several different well spacing by calculating drawdowns. He also prepared salinity maps of groundwater in the Goliad Sand to aid in the design of the desalinization facility.

Determination of Groundwater Availability in the Coastal Bend Water Planning Region.

Project Manager. Groundwater availability is one of the critical issues in the development of a water plan for the Coast Bend Region in South Texas. HDR, teamed with scientists at the Texas A&M University - Corpus Christi, developed a regional groundwater model for the Coastal Bend Water Planning Region. Mr. Land was a technical advisor in the development of the USGS MODFLOW model and lead with the Regional Planning Group in the determination of groundwater availability that is consistent with their willingness to accept a given level of aquifer changes. The model is nearly 200 miles long and 100 miles wide and includes 5 layers. Data from a Geographical Information System is an important component in the development and testing of the model. A calibrated model has been tested for a range of water development and management criteria and has been used to estimate the sustained yield of the aquifer system.

Determination of Groundwater Availability in the Regional Planning Areas.

Project Engineer. Groundwater availability is one of the critical building blocks in the development of water resources and regional water management plans for the SB-1 process. For the Brazos G, South Central Texas, Coastal Bend, and the Llano Estacado water planning regions, Mr. Land has taken the lead in reviewing previous estimates of fresh and saline groundwater availability, revising estimates with better methods, and calculating the groundwater availability for many options that were considered. Many of the options were evaluated with a groundwater modeling analysis.

Review of Groundwater Model for Platte West Well Field (2004-current). Senior Engineer. The Metropolitan Utilities District (MUD) is in the process of expanding the water supplies for Greater Omaha, Nebraska by installing a well field in the Platte River Valley west of Omaha. To plan and permit the water supply facility with 42 wells producing 90 million gallons per day, a groundwater model (MODFLOW) has been

designed and developed by Chatman and Associates, Inc who are under contract with HDR. The model area covers about 650 square miles and has cell dimensions of 100 ft in the vicinity of Platte West Well Field. The model represents, major streams, well pumpage, evapotranspiration, recharge from precipitation and irrigation return flows, and areas outside the model boundary. Mr. Land provided an extensive technical review the models design, calibration, and applications for the district. His comments lead to refining the estimates of recharge and pumpage by irrigation wells, improving the calibration by considering base flow in streams, and clarifying the presentation of effects of Platte West pumping on the surrounding area.

Assessment and Management of Water Supplies in the Republican River Basin.

Project Engineer. The Republican River starts in Colorado, flows into Kansas, then Nebraska, and finally back into Kansas. To allocate the surface water supplies in the late 1930s and early 1940s, the three state formed the Republican River Compact. Since, several reservoirs were constructed to develop the surface water supplies for irrigation and flood control, and wells have been constructed, mostly for irrigation, in all three states. Over the years, the streamflow has been declining; and, Kansas has blamed the upstream states wells as the cause. Mr. Land has assisted Nebraska and its defense team in determining the amount of streamflow declines and the causes. He is very much involved in the development of groundwater flow and stream-reservoir models for legal defense purposes as well as management tools.

Assessment of Aquifer Storage and Recovery in the Brazos River Alluvium. Project Manager. One alternative in expanding the water supplies in the Brazos River basin is to store excess surface water and recover the water during periods of shortage. Mr. Land proposed a concept to divert water from the Brazos River during seasons of high flow and to recharge the nearby Brazos River Alluvium and to recover the water with wells during the season of high summer demands or drought. Mr. Land is testing this concept by the development and application of a MODFLOW groundwater model of the study area.

Calculating Volume of Groundwater in Storage. Project Engineer. The Llano Estacado Regional Water Planning Group is developing long range water plans for the central part of the High Plains Aquifer. In support of the planning, the groundwater in storage was calculated for several counties using aquifer data from wells in several databases, reports, and Geographic Information System software. In addition, the water table was mapped in 1995 and 1995 were prepared and water level changes were calculated.

Determination of Groundwater Assessment and Availability. Project Manager. The San Antonio Water System (SAWS) is in the process of evaluating several Edwards and non-Edwards Aquifer water supply alternatives for future demands. Mr. Land provides leadership and technical support in the evaluation of availability and sustainability of the water supplies from each of these potential projects. The Edwards Aquifer alternatives included groundwater supplies in Kinney and Val Verde Counties. The non-Edwards alternatives have included several locations in the Carrizo-Wilcox, Gulf Coast, and Trinity Aquifers.

Mr. Mark Graves is a process engineer with eight years of experience. His experience includes water distribution and treatment design and costing including membrane treatment, desalination, ozone, biological filters, and disinfection. Mr. Graves also has experience in construction cost estimating and Program Management.

HDR Project Experience

Water Quality and Treatment Model, City of Corpus Christi, Texas. Project Engineer. This model was part of a project to comprehensively assess alternative supply system operation scenarios for the City of Corpus Christi. The City is supplied by two sources of water with different chemical qualities. Additional water sources are being evaluated that also differ from the current supply. A water quality and treatment model was developed to assess the impact on plant operations, costs and finished water quality from different blends of these water sources. A database of source water quality information was compiled for a multi year period and used as input to the model so that seasonal treatment requirements can be assessed. Model output for a range of water blends included the blended water quality including disinfection by-product (DBP) formation potential, total organic carbon, turbidity, and pH. The model then calculates approximate treatment costs and potential treatment problems. Costs are calculated based on coagulant dose required to meet turbidity and DBP requirements, required pH adjustment, chlorine dose to meet residual requirements, and quantity of solids produced. Alerts were triggered for blends of water that cannot be adequately treated with the current treatment process at the O.N. Stevens water plant.

Desalination Facilities Evaluation, City of Corpus Christi, Texas. Project Engineer. Assisted in a feasibility analysis to provide additional water to the Mustang Island-Port Aransas area located on the barrier island offshore of the City of Corpus Christi. The island is currently supplied with water through a water supply pipeline from the mainland. Options to supplement or replace the current water supply with desalinated water from the Gulf of Mexico or brackish water below the island were evaluated. The purpose of this study was to quantify the impact that these new source waters might have on the existing corrosion scales in the SAWS distribution system. The study utilized old, galvanized pipe samples excavated from the SAWS system. These samples were analyzed for scale content and character, and then used in extended pipe loop tests with three different source waters. The waters (and blends of waters) were circulated and stagnated in the loops while water quality changes were monitored. After the potential for iron and corrosion product release was examined, various water conditioning schemes were tested in the loops to determine the treatment requirements and target finished water quality goals for the new sources.
