

Highlights of Changes to Plan Development from
Revised 31 TAC Chapter 357. REGIONAL WATER PLANNING

1. 357.21: Notice Requirements (Ex: 357.21(d) Applications for Funding)
2. 357.22(b): 11-Chapter Format of the Regional Water Plan
3. 357.30(9): Identifying historic drought(s) of record in the planning area description
4. 357.32(d): Using modeled available groundwater (MAGs) and groundwater availability consistent with desired future conditions (DFCs)
5. 357.33(e): Include a secondary water needs analysis for all WUGs and WWP with conservation or direct reuse WMSs
6. 357.34 (d)(3)(B): Include consideration of TCEQ adopted environmental flow standards under 30 TAC Chapter 298
7. 357.35(g)(2): Report a calculated planning management supply factor for each WUG and WWP
8. 357.42: Drought Response Information, Activities, and Recommendations
 - a. 357.42(c): Develop drought response recommendations
 - b. 357.42(d): Collect and submit confidential information regarding infrastructure for emergency interconnections
 - c. 357.42(g): Evaluate potential emergency responses for smaller sole-source entities
 - d. 357.42(j): Develop region-specific model drought contingency plans
