This email is to inform all RWPG members that the Interregional Planning Council's report has been submitted to the TWDB and is now available on the Council's webpage at https://www.twdb.texas.gov/waterplanning/rwp/ipc/2027IPC.asp.

The Council's report includes recommendations to the Texas Legislature, the TWDB, and future Interregional Planning Councils, as they relate to the Councils' three statutory charges.

These charges include 1) improve coordination among the RWPGs, and between the RWPGs and the TWDB in meeting goals of the state water planning process; 2) facilitate dialogue regarding regional water management strategies; and 3) share operational best practices of the regional water planning process.

The Council's report also includes several observations on topics not related to the statutory charges, including water loss, unaccounted water use, and long-range and visionary planning.

The report is being distributed for planning group consideration during development of the 2026 Regional Water Plans. RWPG consultants may review and consider recommendations from the Council under the regional water planning contract scope of work Task 8.
