Dear RWPG Members,

The TWDB Groundwater and Water Supply Planning Divisions recently concluded the Modeled Available Groundwater (MAG) review as part of the data structuring process for the 2027 state water planning database. The TWDB worked closely with Groundwater Management Areas through this process.

The MAGs are used in the development of draft irrigation water demand projections to determine if any counties may be constrained by future groundwater availability. When the draft irrigation demand projections were developed and shared with RWPGs in August 2022, some GMAs had not completed the MAG development process. Since this process is now complete, the TWDB staff re-ran the irrigation demand projections and identified two regions where draft projections have changed (Regions A and G). No other changes were made to previously shared irrigation demand projections. All updated MAG data is included in the attached workbook.

The deadline for submitting all requested revisions to draft non-municipal water demand projections is **July 14, 2023**, although regions and their consultants are **strongly encouraged** to communicate with the TWDB staff and submit revision requests and supporting documentation as early as possible to allow adequate time for evaluation and follow up, as needed.
