a) Bills relevant to Regional Water Planning

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Agenda Item 2: Legislative Update (cont.) Bills of interest that passed

HB 1565 - TWDB Sunset Bill

- RWPGs will report on implementation of large projects.
- RWPGs may plan for conditions worse than drought of record.
- These provisions already in planning contract.

SB 28/SJR 75 - Texas Water Fund

- Establishes \$1 billion Texas Water Fund, subject to voter approval, which can provide additional funding for existing TWDB financial assistance programs.
- Can also fund the New Water Supply for Texas Fund for water supply projects from new sources.
 - o At least \$250 million of funds appropriated to the Texas Water Fund must be used for the New Water Supply for Texas Fund
- The Texas Water Fund will take effect January 1, 2024, if SJR 75 is approved by the voters. All other provisions of SB 28 take effect September 1, 2023.

HB 1 - Budget Bill

- Passed budget includes additional funding for RWPGs.
- o Specific region amounts to be determined and planning contracts amended in Fall 2023.



Agenda Item 2: Legislative Update (cont.) Bills of interest that did not pass

HB 4373/SB 2108

- TWDB Legislative priority bills for Regional Water Planning.
- Original bill text would have removed the requirement to place a printed copy of the Initially Prepared Plan (IPP) in each county courthouse and one public library in each county in the planning area.
- Would have also allowed notice of the IPP hearing to be posted on the planning group's website, instead of published in newspapers.

b) Chairs feedback



a) Fall contract amendments

- Received an additional \$1.3M in annual appropriations for regional water planning
- To be incorporated into existing contracts this fall
- iii. Amendments will increase total project cost and committed funds
- Subject to TWDB Board authorization (anticipated late summer)

b) Projections deadlines

- Upcoming deadlines:
 - 7/14/23 for non-municipal demands
 - 8/11/23 for population and municipal demands
- Action items recommended to include flexibility for consultants to continue coordination

- Recent questions on origin of population projections:
 - First 30 years of population projections (by county) developed by the Texas Demographic Center
 - The Texas Demographic Center's 30 years of county-level population trends are driven by the current demographic profile of population
 - TWDB staff extends projections for 20 years and allocates to WUGS
- RWPGs strongly encouraged to coordinate with TWDB in advance of adopting remaining revisions

- Technical Memorandum due to TWDB March 4, 2024
 - Population, demands, availability and supplies, and needs data reports
 - RWPG process to identify potentially feasible water management strategies (WMSs)
 - List of potentially feasible WMS identified to date
 - List of infeasible WMS and projects identified from the 2021 RWPs
 - Summary of region's interregional coordination efforts do date
 - Full list of deliverable requirements in RWP Contract Exhibit C, Section 2.12.1
 - Meeting to approve Technical Memorandum requires 14-day notice/comment period

- Activities to occur prior to Technical Memorandum approval
 - Approve and submit hydrologic variances
 - Consider any changes to WWPs or MWPs identified by region
 - Identify infeasible WMSs and projects from the 2021 RWPs
 - Hold public meeting to identify potentially feasible WMS process for 2026
 RWPs and present results of infeasible WMS analysis from 2021 RWPs
 - This meeting requires 14-day notice/comment period and may occur at the same meeting the RWPGs approves Technical Memorandum

- Additional upcoming activities
 - RWPG approval to submit notice to proceed request for region-specific scope of work to TWDB
 - Specific to scope of work Task 5B (Evaluation and Recommendation of WMS/Projects)
 - Consultants may not commence work on any Task 5B work prior to approval
 - Regions must approve methodology for identifying potentially feasible WMS and identify potentially feasible WMSs to date **prior** to action on notice to proceed
 - Reimbursement of funds for Task 5B strictly prohibited until TWDB issues notice to proceed

- Additional upcoming activities
 - Consider timing of amendments to remove infeasible WMS from 2021
 RWPs
 - Any resulting amendments must be adopted by the RWPG and submitted to the TWDB by June 4, 2024
 - Action to commence amendment process should occur no later than when planning group approves Technical Memorandum
 - TWDB coordination with consultants on data entry
 - Uniform costing model update

- d) TWDB coordination with State Climatologist
 - General update on Sunset recommendation for TWDB to consult with State Climatologist
