The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) will conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Water Code §16.053(r) and 31 Texas Administrative Code §357.51(f) and §358.4(a) on Monday, June 29, 2015 to receive public comment on proposed amendments to the 2012 State Water Plan, *Water for Texas 2012*. The Board seeks to receive public comment related to the incorporation of changes adopted by the Region C regional water planning group to its adopted regional water plan on April 20, 2015. Specifically, Region C proposed to add project details and capital costs to the water loss components of the previously recommended conservation water management strategy for the cities of Bedford and Fort Worth. On May 5, 2015, TWDB received the 2011 Region C regional water plan amendment materials and request for approval. These materials were reviewed by TWDB staff and the amendment to the regional water plan was approved by the Board on May 19, 2015.

The Board also seeks to receive public comment related to the incorporation of changes adopted by the Region L regional water planning group to its adopted regional water plan on April 2, 2015. Specifically, Region L substituted an alternative water management strategy of the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's Lower Basin Storage Project for the previously recommended configuration of the Lower Basin Storage Project. The Executive Administrator approved the water management strategy substitution on November 3, 2014.
