SUBJECT: Gifts and donations of \$500 or more in value given to the Texas Water Development Board

ACTION REQUESTED

Consideration and acknowledgment of gifts and donations of \$500 or more in value given to the Texas Water Development Board in accordance with Chapter 575 of the Texas Government Code.

BACKGROUND

Chapter 575 of the Government Code gives specific direction to state agencies regarding the acceptance of gifts and donations. Chapter 575 requires that the Board acknowledge the acceptance of all gifts of money or property with a value of \$500 or more in an open meeting no later than the 90th day after the date the gift is accepted. The name of the donor, a description of the gift or donation, and a statement of the purpose of the gift or donation must be recorded in the minutes.

The signed Executive Administrator's approval memorandum, without attachments, is attached as Exhibit "A." The resolution attached as Exhibit "B" includes a list of gifts and donations including all travel expenses paid for by a third party organization. This resolution, with the attachment, will be recorded in the minutes.

RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Administrator recommends the acknowledgement of gifts and donations of \$500 or more in value given to the Texas Water Development Board in order to comply with Chapter 575 of the Texas Government Code.

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

SUBJECT: **Gifts and Donations to the Agency**

Chapter 575 of the Texas Government Code gives specific direction to state agencies regarding the acceptance of gifts and donations. Chapter 575 provides that the Board must acknowledge the acceptance of all gifts of money or property with a value of \$500.00 or more in an open meeting no later than the 90th day after the date the gift is accepted. Chapter 575 further states the name of the donor, the description of the gift or donation, and a statement of the purpose of the gift or donation must be recorded in the minutes.

Your signature below is needed to accept the gifts and donations. It is recommended you sign this form and accept the gifts and donations.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD
