1. Consider authorizing the Executive Administrator to amend the boundary between Groundwater Management Area 6 and Groundwater Management Area 8. (Natalie Ballew)
2. Consider authorizing the Executive Administrator to negotiate and execute contracts with engineering firms selected to conduct flood modeling and mapping services, not to exceed \$10,000,000 per contract. (Manuel Razo)
3. Consider authorizing the Executive Administrator to execute an amendment to an interagency contract with the University of Texas at Arlington to renew the contract and increase the contract total by an amount not to exceed an additional \$634,964 to provide engineering services. (Clay Schultz)
4. Approve by resolution a request from Hidalgo County Drainage District No. 1 (Hidalgo County) for \$32,670,000 in financial assistance consisting of \$22,869,000 in financing and \$9,801,000 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for acquisition and construction of a flood improvement project. 5. Approve by resolution a request from the Cameron County Drainage District No. 5 (Cameron County) for \$4,340,000 in financial assistance consisting of \$2,000,000 in financing and \$2,340,000 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for planning, design, and construction of a channel improvement and detention pond project. (Shubham Aggarwal)
6. Approve by resolution a request from the Cameron County Drainage District No. 5 (Cameron County) for \$5,003,000 in financial assistance consisting of \$2,000,000 in financing and \$3,003,000 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for planning, design, and construction of a channel improvement and detention pond project. (Shubham Aggarwal)
7. Approve by resolution a request from the Cameron County Drainage District No. 5 (Cameron County) for \$3,560,000 in financial assistance consisting of \$2,000,000 in financing and \$1,560,000 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for planning, design, and construction of a channel improvement and detention pond project. (Shubham Aggarwal)
8. Approve by resolution a request from the City of Tyler (Smith County) for \$28,000 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for planning of a flood study project. (Mireya Loewe)

9. Approve by resolution a request from the City of Tyler (Smith County) for \$62,400 in grant from the Flood Infrastructure Fund for planning of a flood study project. (Mireya Loewe)
10. Approve by resolution a request from the Greater Texoma Utility Authority on behalf of Lake Kiowa Special Utility District (Cooke County) for \$5,470,000 in financing from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund for planning, design, and construction of a waterline replacement project. (Joe Koen)
11. Approve by resolution a request from the City of New Braunfels (Comal and Guadalupe Counties) for \$40,000,000 in financing from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund for planning, design, and construction of a water system expansion project. (Dain Larsen)
12. Texas Water Conditions Report (Dr. Mark Wentzel)
13. The Board will receive comments from the public on any matters within the jurisdiction of the TWDB, with the exception of matters which are subject to the ex parte prohibition found in Texas Government Code Section 2001.061.
14. The Board may adjourn into Executive Session and conduct a closed meeting to consider any item on this agenda if a matter is raised that is appropriate for the Board to conduct a private consultation with its attorney on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. The Board may conduct a closed meeting to receive legal advice and discuss pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers, or the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of specific Board employees, including the Executive Administrator and General Counsel, as permitted by Sections 551.071 and 551.074, the Texas Open Meetings Act, codified as Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. The Board may also meet in open meeting to take action on legal or personnel matters considered in the closed meeting as required by Section 551.102 of the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Government Code. The Board may conduct a closed meeting to consider and discuss financial matters related to the investment or potential investment of the Board's funds, as permitted by Section 6.0601(a) of the Texas Water Code. The Board may also meet in open meeting to take action on a financial matter discussed in the closed meeting as required by Section 6.0601(b) of the Texas Water Code.

The next currently scheduled meeting of the Texas Water Development Board will be March 25, 2021. Other meetings may be scheduled and will be posted in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.
