## Clean & Drinking Water State Revolving Funds

### Draft Amended Intended Use Plans

### Disaster Recovery Response

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is proposing to make additional resources available to help impacted communities fully recover as rapidly as possible from Hurricane Harvey. The proposed amendments to these two programs will offer a total of \$12 Million in principal forgiveness and \$78 Million of loan funds at a zero percent interest rate for Emergency Relief and Urgent Need projects, bringing a total of \$90 Million of special assistance for disaster recovery.

The TWDB is holding a period of public review and comment before approval and adoption of the draft amended State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2018 State Revolving Fund (SRF) Intended Use Plans (IUPs). These documents are available online:
