

# Clean and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds Emerging Contaminants Programs Project Priority Invitation State Fiscal Year 2023

## *Project Information Forms due June 7*

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) invites entities to submit information on projects to be included in the current fiscal year's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program [“CWSRF Emerging Contaminants” Intended Use Plan \(IUP\)](#) and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program [“DWSRF Emerging Contaminants” IUP](#).

To be included in the initial Project Priority Lists for State Fiscal Year 2023, entities must submit a completed Project Information Form (PIF) no later than midnight on **Wednesday, June 7**:

*Note: the TWDB is not able to use the Online Loan Application System (OLA) for these submittals. PIFs **must** be submitted by email using the Microsoft Word version of the form.*

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act appropriated additional funds for the SRF programs, including appropriations specific **to reduce exposure to perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and other emerging contaminants** through drinking water and to help address discharges through wastewater and, potentially, nonpoint sources. This year, \$4,103,040 in funding is available for the new CWSRF Emerging Contaminants program and \$56,833,920 is available for the new DWSRF Emerging Contaminants program. **All project funding will be in the form of principal forgiveness.**

The TWDB may also use PIFs received under the new DWSRF Emerging Contaminants program to consider funding under the separate EPA Emerging Contaminants in Small or Disadvantaged Communities Grants program, which has a \$114,696,000 allotment for Texas.

Additional requirements for applying for financial assistance and further details regarding eligibility, project prioritization system, and the invitation process are available in the draft Intended Use Plan.
