



## Public Comment Period: Flood Infrastructure Fund Intended Use Plan

*Comment period ends Friday, June 12*

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) invites stakeholders to review and comment on the proposed [Flood Infrastructure Fund \(FIF\) Intended Use Plan \(IUP\) for State Fiscal Year \(SFY\) 2026-2027](#). During the 88th Legislative Session, Senate Bill 30 provided additional general revenue funding to support the FIF program, and related program updates resulting from this legislation are also being implemented.

The draft FIF IUP outlines the proposed structure and types of financial assistance available for projects funded through the FIF program. Details included in the draft IUP address eligibility requirements, minimum standards, the program timeline, financial assistance categories, prioritization criteria, and other programmatic information.

The FIF program assists in financing drainage, flood mitigation, and flood control projects including:

- planning and design activities;
- work to obtain necessary regulatory approvals;
- construction and implementation of flood projects; and
- multi-purpose flood mitigation and drainage infrastructure projects that control, divert, capture, or impound floodwater, stormwater, agricultural runoff, or treated wastewater effluent and treat and distribute the water for use as an additional water supply source.

The public comment period for the draft FIF IUP **begins Wednesday, May 13, and closes at 11:59 p.m. CDT on Friday, June 12**. All public comments must be submitted using the online Public Comment form linked below. Abridged applications provide the information needed for project prioritization. Projects that receive priority for financial assistance are invited to submit a complete application.
