



Application Solicitation Period for Texas Water Supply Corporation Grant Opportunity Now Open

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) has opened the full application solicitation period for the Texas Water Supply Corporation Grants (TWSCG) Opportunity, established through the Texas Water Fund. Full applications are due on Wednesday, January 13, 2027, at 11:59 p.m. CST. For more information on the TWSCG opportunity, please see our September 10th [Board meeting agenda item](#).

The TWSCG opportunity provides 100 percent grant funding for eligible water supply and water infrastructure projects. The TWDB is making up to \$50 million in one-time grant funding available to eligible Water Supply Corporations through the Rural Water Assistance Fund (RWAF) and the Water Loss Assistance Fund (WLAF). The TWSCG opportunity was developed in accordance with the Texas Water Fund Implementation Plan presented by the Executive Administrator on July 24, 2024. Funding supports water supply, water conservation strategies, and water loss mitigation. Funding is intended to assist Water Supply Corporations in addressing critical infrastructure needs while supporting the long-term reliability and sustainability of water systems.

To be eligible for funding, applicants must be organized as a Water Supply Corporation that serves existing residential customers. Entities whose primary service is to commercial or industrial customers are not eligible to apply. Additional eligibility requirements, prioritization criteria, project categories, funding limits, and administrative conditions are described in the TWSCG Implementation Plan.

Full application submittal details will be released on the TWSCG webpage, and applicants should ensure they follow all instructions provided in the application materials. This application process differs from the TWDB's traditional abridged or full applications and is needed to prioritize projects. Projects that receive priority consideration will be notified of next steps in the process. To qualify, applicants must have up-to-date financial audits, water use surveys, water loss audits, and water conservation plans/annual reports, and proposed projects must be consistent with the State Water Plan; no waivers are allowed.
