Clean and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds Emerging Contaminants Programs Project Priority Invitation State Fiscal Year 2026

Project Information Forms due March 6, 2026

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) invites entities to submit information on projects to be included in the current fiscal year's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Emerging Contaminants (EC) program and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) EC program Intended Use Plans (IUP).

To be included in the initial Project Priority Lists for State Fiscal Year 2026, entities must submit a completed Project Information Form **by 5:00 p.m., CST on Friday, March 6, 2026**:

*Note: The TWDB is not able to use the Online Loan Application System (OLA) for these submittals. PIFs **must** be submitted by email using the Microsoft Word version of the form. Please submit the PIF (and any attachments) as **one PDF**.*

ATTENTION: The release of the U.S. Census 2024 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year estimates data used to determine an entity's disadvantaged community eligibility has been delayed due to the federal government shutdown. The 2024 ACS 5-year estimates data will not be available until early February. Entities should complete this PIF with the data currently available; the TWDB will utilize the updated 2024 ACS 5-year estimates during the ranking and review process.

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act appropriated additional funds for the SRF programs, including appropriations specific **to reducing exposure to perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and other emerging contaminants** through drinking water and helping address discharges through wastewater and, potentially, nonpoint sources. **All project funding will be in the form of principal forgiveness.**

The TWDB may also use PIFs received under this new DWSRF Emerging Contaminants program to consider funding under the separate EPA Emerging Contaminants in Small or Disadvantaged Communities (EC-SDC) program.

If your proposed project contains components that may not be eligible for EC funding, you are encouraged to submit a PIF for the DWSRF or CWSRF General Activities IUP, so that those components can be considered for alternative funding sources.
