



## Abridged Application Period for 2025 SWIFT Funding Cycle Now Open

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) has opened the abridged application period for the 2025 funding cycle of the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas (SWIFT)\* program. Abridged applications are due on Monday, February 3. For more information regarding the 2025 SWIFT funding cycle, please see the [Board meeting agenda item](#).

The SWIFT program helps communities develop and optimize water supplies at cost-effective rates. The program provides low-interest financing, extended repayment terms, deferral of repayments, and incremental repurchase terms for projects with state ownership aspects. It also includes additional interest rate subsidies for rural and agricultural projects.

To be eligible for financial assistance from the SWIFT program, projects must be recommended water management strategy projects with an associated nonzero capital cost in the [2022 State Water Plan](#) at the time abridged applications are due.

Abridged applications are due by **Monday, February 3, 2025**, at 5:00 p.m. CST and may be submitted via the TWDB's [online application system](#) or by [paper copy](#). These short applications provide information the TWDB needs to complete prioritization of the projects. Projects that receive priority for financial assistance will be invited to submit a complete application, which will include a detailed financial, legal, engineering, and environmental review.

\*The SWIFT program includes two funds, the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas (SWIFT) and the State Water Implementation Revenue Fund for Texas (SWIRFT). Revenue bonds for the program are issued through SWIRFT.
