Committee Members proposes that the Trinity and Gulf Coast Aquifers to be designated as non-relevant since there is no production within the GMA 13. The Edward Aquifer in Atascosa County was to be designated as non-relevant since they are regulated by the Edwards Aquifer Authority and non-relevant in Zavala County due to the absence of a Groundwater Conservation District. The committee discussed the Edwards aquifer in Frio County and noted that current wells produce an average artesian flow of 750 gallons. The GMA 13 Committee proposes a recommendation of a DFC of an average artesian flow of 500 gallons per minute. WHEREAS; GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA (GMA) 13 IS COMPRISED OF DELEGATES FROM THE FOLLOWING GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICTS LOCATED WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY WITHIN GMA 13: EVERGREEN UWCD, GONZALES COUNTY UWCD, GUADALUPE COUNTY GCD, EDWARDS AQUIFER AUTHORITY, MEDINA COUNTY GCD, UVALDE COUNTY UWCD, WINTERGARDEN GCD, PLUM CREEK CD AND MCMULLEN GCD; AND

WHEREAS; CHAPTER 36.108 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE, JOINT PLANNING IN MANAGEMENT AREA, REQUIRES THAT THE GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICTS IN THE GMA ADOPT DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS OF ALL RELEVANT AQUIFERS IN THE GMA FOR THE NEXT FIFTY YEAR HORIZON, NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1, 2010; AND

WHEREAS; IN REFERENCE TO GAM RUN T10-012, TABLE C-1, THE COMMITTEE HAS CONSIDERED, THE BASE SCENARIO OF AN AVERAGE DRAWDOWN OF 0.0 FEET, SCENARIO 2.5 AN AVERAGE DRAWDOWN OF 1 FOOT, SCENARIO 3.0 AN AVERAGE DRAWDOWN OF 1 FOOT, AND SCENARIO 4.0 AN AVERAGE DRAWDOWN OF 2 FEET FOR THE YEGUAJACKSON AQUIFER; AND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, THE DISTRICT MEMBERS OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 13, ADOPT SCENARIO 4.0, AND A AVERAGE DRAWDOWN OF 2 FEET FOR THE YEGUA-JACKSON AQUIFER; AND;


