Dear Mr. Ward:

As presiding officer of Groundwater Management Area 7 (GMA 7), I am submitting the enclosed Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for the aquifers in GMA 7, pursuant to Section 36.108 of the Texas Water Code. After many months of evaluating numerous Groundwater Availability Modeling scenarios, Aquifer Assessments, TWDB technical advice, and other technical advice, the 19 members of GMA 7 present at the July 29, 2010 meeting voted unanimously to adopt nine DFC resolutions. These resolutions include: the Dockum, Ellenburger-San Saba, Hickory, Lipan, Ogallala, Capitan Reef, Rustler, Marble Falls, and Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) aquifers.

The Desired Future Condition of a 7 foot average drawdown for the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau), the only major aquifer in GMA 7, is based on Scenario 10 of GAM Run 09-35, except for a 1 foot drawdown in Kinney County which is based on Scenario 3 of GAM Run 09-35. The remaining minor aquifers have various drawdowns.

The enclosed documents are:

- 1. Groundwater Management Area 7 Desired Future Conditions Resolutions # 07-29-10-1 through 07-29-10-9, the readopted Resolution # 05-21-10-3, and the voting record sheet (Exhibit A);
- 2. Groundwater Management Area 7 member districts' meeting notices for the July 29, 2010 meeting in which it adopted its DFC Resolutions (Exhibit B);
- 3. Groundwater Management Area 7 meeting minutes for the July 29, 2010 meeting, which were approved at a separate meeting on July 29, 2010 (Exhibit C); and
- 4. Groundwater Management Area 7 unapproved meeting minutes for the separate meeting on July 29, 2010 (Exhibit D).





- 6) A status report on the GAM requests for the Ellenburger-San Saba and Hickory aquifers was given by Robert Bradley of the TWDB. The final report is complete on the Ellenburger-San Saba and the Hickory will be completed shortly.
- 7) Dr. Bill Hutchinson of the TWDB gave a presentation on the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) groundwater availability model and a status report on GAM run requests. Dr. Hutchinson reviewed the changes that have been made to the model. The historic pumping numbers have been updated and corrected. Dr. Hutchinson went through pumping scenarios 1 through 5 to show the changes in drawdown throughout the aquifer in response to changes in pumping. Additional scenarios 6 and 7 were drafted at this time based on pumping changes recommended by GMA 7 members.

Following the presentation by Dr. Hutchinson, the GMA 7 Joint Planning Meeting was recessed.

Joint Planning Meeting Recessed at 11:06 a.m.

Public Meeting Called to Order at 11:06 a.m.

A Public Meeting was held in order to receive comments on Draft Desired Future Conditions for the Capitan Reef, Rustler, and Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) aquifers.

- 1. A draft resolution for DFCs for the Capitan Reef aquifer was presented based on information submitted by the Middle Pecos GCD. Comments: Randy Williams made comments in response to Robert Bradley's statement that methodology for arriving at DFCs will have to be submitted with the submission packet. Randy stated that the drawdown numbers for the Capitan Reef aquifer were derived from a two dimensional spread sheet model. The maps and data were provided by the TWDB. He will provide the methodology information to GMA 7 for inclusion with the DFC info.
- A draft resolution declaring the Rustler aquifer not relevant was presented based on information received from the Middle Pecos GCD.
 Comments: Randy Williams commented that there was an error in communication. A DFC for the Rustler was derived from a model similar to the Capitan Reef and that the DFC for the Rustler aquifer should state that the drawdown is not to exceed 300 feet.
- 3. A draft resolution for the DFC for the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) aquifer was presented. The draft resolution set out four different DFC categories for specific member districts. Comments: There was discussion about the differences in using individual district DFCs versus an average aquifer wide DFC based on drawdown scenarios for each district. Dr. Hutchinson stated that GMAs have been submitting them both ways. However, the aquifer average gives districts a little more flexibility.

Ron Fieseler, general manager of the Blanco-Pedernales GCD commented that GMA 9 adopted an aquifer-wide average and he supports that approach.

Cord Switzer, a resident of Gillespie County, commented that the GCDs have done an ineffective job of communicating with the public. Jim Polonis and Lee Sweeten explained some of the measures that had been taken to inform the public.

Dr. Hutchinson was requested to draft scenario 8 based on pumping changes recommended by GMA 7 members.

There were no other comments.

Public Meeting Adjourned at 11:54 a.m.

c. Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) aquifer --- Discussions were held on additional draft scenarios 9 and 10 of GAM 09-35 utilizing different pumping rates and the setting of individual district DFCs versus an aquifer-wide DFC.

Motion by Jim Polonis, second by Winton Milliff to adopt an aquifer-wide average DFC with an incorporated scenario, with an exception for Kinney County GCD which is basing its DFC on spring flow, and to include a statement that the aquifer is not relevant for some parts of GMA 7.

Motion Passed 19-0.

No further discussion was held on the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau) aquifer.

Motion by Perry Bushong, second by Jim Polonis to adopt DFC Resolution # 7-29-10-9
using Scenario 10 along with the Kinney County spring flow and declaring the EdwardsTrinity aquifer not relevant for joint planning purposes within some parts of GMA 7.

Motion Passed 19-0.

It was noted that with the adoption of the DFC Resolutions for the various aquifers within GMA 7, there may be some inconsistencies with previously adopted resolutions that declared some of the aquifers not relevant for planning purposes within GMA 7.
