

Parking for Visitors of the Texas Water Development Board

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is located at 1700 Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas, on the 6th floor of the Stephen F. Austin building. Because the State of Texas has embarked on a large-scale construction project near our building, driving and parking in the area has been affected. The only street remaining fully open by the TWDB’s building is Colorado Street. Parking is extremely limited.

We suggest the following parking options:

Fee-based parking in the Bob Bullock State History Museum parking garage, 1800 Congress Avenue. This garage is across the street from our building and the closest parking facility:
