



Public Comment Period: Clean and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds Emerging Contaminants Funding Draft Intended Use Plans with Project Lists

Comment period ends Friday, July 24

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is holding a period of public review and comment before the approval and adoption of the draft state fiscal year 2026 State Revolving Fund (SRF) Intended Use Plans (IUPs) for the federal fiscal year 2025 / state fiscal year 2026 Clean and Drinking Water SRF Emerging Contaminants funding. These draft IUPs include the ranked project priority lists.

Any funding provided is dependent upon the outcome of TWDB review of the project details in a submitted application.
