Subject: Water in Chatfield, TX (better known as Timothy, TX)

I know that these comments are late because it is now 6:00 p.m., but I did not receive an official notice in the mail, I just stumbled upon this announcement about these hearings and hope that my comments are accepted. As a matter of concern, I know of no one in this community that received a notice of this draft proposal.

The residents in Chatfield, TX (better known as Timothy, Texas) has been paying taxes for over 75 years and has never received consideration for an approved water system. It is ridiculous to ignore small communities and expose them to risks to viruses, disease and sickness. The community itself is surrounded by water sources and resources (Ennis, Tx, Seven Points, Tx and all the surrounding communities). To demonstrate how neglected the community is (1) there is no road sign identifying the small community/town, what happened does it not exist? (2) It is identified as Chatfield, but Chatfield disowns it? (3) It is in Navarro county for land tax purposes but in Ennis/Ellis County for School Tax purposes? (4) Answer this, what entity is responsible for the basic necessities and well being of the Timothy/Chatfield Community? The nearby commercial sand and gravel people (and whomever can pay the price) come down and disturb and possibly contaminate water and natural resources, but the poor community pays in unaffordable health costs. The Timothy community has been so neglected by government plans, etc. Did you know that real people and children, Tax paying American Citizens (so what, they are poor, they still have a right to the same benefits as the rich as far as the basics of life, and decent drinking water is one of them) live in Timothy, Texas.

The Community of Timothy should be given priority over any proposed water project due to its long term neglect and unattendance, with no cost to them to the residents, as they have paid in the many prior years to support other communities. The Timothy Community is a wholesome and vital community for those who wish to expose their children to the real meaning of the American Life and to explore the spirit of wildlife and the perservation of our natural resources.
