

- EXPLANATION**
- Well used for control
  - Top number indicates altitude of top of the Paluxy Formation, in feet above or below (-) mean sea level
  - Bottom number indicates depth to top of the Paluxy Formation, in feet below land surface
  - x Other control point
  - Number indicates altitude of top of the Paluxy Formation, in feet above mean sea level
  - Data points may be on the main outcrop or in streambeds and roadcuts
  - 500— Line showing approximate altitude of top of the Paluxy Formation
  - Interval 100 feet
  - Datum is mean sea level
  - ▲ Approximate downip limit of fresh to slightly saline water in the Paluxy Formation
  - ▲▲▲▲ Approximate limit of the Paluxy Formation
  - Outcrop of the Paluxy Formation
  - Contact
