**11. Detailed statement of the purpose for which the money will be used.**

The purpose of the requested funding is to prepare the State mandated 2011 Region F Water Plan. The updated water plan is intended to meet legislative and regulatory requirements while addressing changed conditions since the completion of the 2006 plan. Region F is a large planning area, covering 32 counties in the Upper Colorado and Rio Grande river basins. The region continues to experience drought conditions, prompting local water providers to continue to identify and evaluate water supply alternatives. This planning grant outlines the activities necessary to meet legislative and regulatory requirements and update changed conditions to maintain the quality and integrity of the Region F Water Plan and the planning process.

**12. Detailed description of why state funding assistance is needed.**

**Base Funding Request**

The Legislature has mandated that the regional water plans be updated every five years. The Region F Water Planning Group is expected to produce its next plan by January 2011. The Legislature has allocated funding for this effort and is expected to allocate additional funding in 2009 to provide the funds necessary to complete the 2011 regional

water plans. It is appropriate for the TWDB to award funds to the Region F Water Planning Group to enable them to meet the state-mandated requirements.

The base funding request is to meet legislative and regulatory requirements, including the public participation process outlined by the Legislature. The TWDB has identified required components for the 2011 regional water plans that will require the region to review and update each of the ten chapters of the 2006 Region F Water Plan. In addition, Region F will need to incorporate the findings and recommendations from six studies currently being conducted for regional water planning. More detailed descriptions of the required activities for each chapter update are included in the Scope of Work in Exhibit IV.

The TWDB has proposed a budget allocation for each region for the development of the base plan. Region F has adjusted allocations by chapter in an attempt to honor the total base funding allocation amount. However, to properly prepare an updated plan and provide planning information to 32 counties, funding beyond the original TWDB proposed budget is required to meet statutory requirements. This planning grant does not request any additional funds beyond what is needed for the basic plan update.

**13. Identify potential sources and amounts of funding available for implementation of viable solutions resulting from proposed planning.**

Viable projects are to be implemented by individual water providers and other beneficiaries, not by the Region F Water Planning Group. Funding will vary considerably depending on the type of project and the economic resources of the beneficiaries. Potential sources of funding include but are not limited to income from water sales, municipal taxes, bond sales, federal and state loan programs, state participation funds, and grants from federal programs.

**DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK  
REGION F WATER PLANNING GROUP**

The scope of work for the development of the 2011 Region F Water Plan as presented below outlines the minimum activities to meet legislative and regulatory requirements. The budget requests by chapter that exceed the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) estimated base funding amounts are identified as “additional base funding”.

**Chapter 1. Description of Region**

The objective of this task is to update the description of the region in the 2006 Region F Water Plan. It will require updating the text to describe changed conditions and new studies completed or underway since the 2006 Water Plan. Budget and scope for this task will be a limited effort with minimal changes to tables and figures.

**This task will include updating the following:**

- Text to reflect any changed conditions in Region F. This will include a brief discussion of the renewed oil and gas activities and wind generation in the region, population trends since the 2000 census and other changes identified during the planning process.
- Descriptions of wholesale water providers as needed.
- Review and update as needed the list of threatened and endangered species in Region F counties.
- Descriptions of studies and plans completed since the 2006 Region F plan and on-going studies within the region.
- Current preparation for drought conditions.
- Add information compiled by the TWDB from water loss audits performed by retail public utilities pursuant to 31 TAC §358.6.

**Base Funding Request .....\$10,000**

**Deliverable:** Updated Chapter 1 of the 2011 Region F Water Plan.

**Chapter 2. Current and Projected Population and Water Demands**

The focus of this task is to update projected populations and water demands based on changed conditions. The Texas Water Development Board will not be developing new population or water demand projections for the 2011 regional water plans with the exception of steam electric power demands. It is anticipated that there will not be significant revisions to the population and water demands projections in Region F. The effort for this task will include reviewing and approving the new steam electric power demands and updating demands for wholesale water providers. A high level review of the mining demands will also be performed.

**List of entities with anticipated demand review and/or revisions:**

**This task will include the following:**

- Review newly developed steam electric power demands
  - Revise tables and figures with new demands
  - Request revisions to demands as needed
- Review list of wholesale water providers
- Review and update demands on wholesale water providers, including new and changed contracts

**Base Funding Request .....\$8,000**

- Review projected irrigation demands that show 2010 projections that are more than 200% of historical use and greater than 5,000 acre-feet above 2006 use. This includes Tom Green, Upton, Ward and Winkler Counties. Request revisions to these demands as directed by the Region F planning group and submit appropriate documentation to TWDB.
- Collect water use from the Railroad Commission, groundwater districts and other available sources on oil and gas activities in Region F. Compare the data to existing mining demands. Include discussion of the water usage for mining in Chapter 2.
- Update text, tables and figures in Chapter 2.
- Update TWDB database as needed

**Additional Base Funding Request .....\$16,000**

**Deliverable:** Updated Chapter 2 of the 2011 Region F Water Plan.

**Chapter 3. Water Supply Analysis**

This task focuses on updating water supplies in Region F based on changed conditions and requirements for the 2011 regional water plans. For the 2011 plans, surface water supplies must include reporting of firm yield. Allocations of supply can be limited to safe yield supply, operational yield or other factors. The 2011 Region F Water Plan will allocate surface water supplies from reservoirs on a safe yield basis. This is the standard used by the water providers in the region and used in previous regional water plans.

Groundwater supplies must comply with Managed Available Groundwater (MAG) values as determined by the TWDB and Groundwater Management Areas if this information is available. For Region F, the MAG values will not be available for incorporation in the 2011 water plan. However, based on information gathered in the groundwater study completed in the first round of planning, water supplies for selected counties may be changed. A list of these counties and the affected aquifers may be found below. Additional effort for this task includes updating allocations of supplies to water users and wholesale providers based on new projects completed, changes in contracts or other changed conditions.

- Report firm yields of reservoirs for Region F sources.
- Update water availability for surface water sources in the Pecan Bayou watershed based on the findings of the 1<sup>st</sup> biennium study.
- Review and update reuse water quantities.
- Update supplies available to water user groups based on changes in contracts and/or new supplies.
- Update supplies available to wholesale water providers based on changes in contracts and/or new supplies.

**Base Funding Request .....\$8,000**

- Review and update groundwater supplies for the following aquifers and counties: Ogallala (Andrews), Other aquifer (Runnels, Coke, Menard, Sterling, Glasscock), Edwards-Trinity Plateau (Schleicher, Sutton, Crockett, Glasscock, Reagan), Pecos Valley Alluvium (Ward, Crane, Winkler) based on the findings from the 1<sup>st</sup> biennium Groundwater Study.
- Include discussion of the status of developing Managed Available Groundwater.

- Update text, tables and figures in Chapter 3.
- Update TWDB database as needed.

**Additional Base Funding Request .....\$17,000**

**Deliverable:** Updated Chapter 3 of the 2011 Region F Water Plan.

**Chapter 4. Identification, Evaluation and Selection of Water Management Strategies**

The objective of this task is to update water management strategies in the 2006 Region F Water Plan and evaluate new strategies that may be identified for the 2011 water plan. This includes updating strategies that were recommended to meet a water need and those considered, but not recommended. As part of the 2011 plan, the Regional Water Planning Group will be able to identify alternative water management strategies. All alternative strategies will be evaluated to the same level as recommended strategies. Also, capital and annual cost estimates for all strategies must be updated to 2007 dollars.

Tables 1 through 4 show water management strategies retained for further evaluation, water management strategies that have already been implemented and no longer need inclusion in the Region F plan, strategies that may be dropped from further consideration because they were not recommended strategies in the previous Region F plan and are unlikely to prove feasible, and strategies that may require updating due to changed conditions. All water user groups and wholesale water providers will be contacted to verify the recommended strategies in the 2006 regional water plan are still applicable and identify potential new strategies that the entity may be considering.

A major strategy for the Region F Water Planning Area is the Colorado River Basin Subordination Strategy (F07SUBORD). This strategy includes modifications to the Colorado River Basin Water Availability Model developed in conjunction with Region K. Region F intends to retain this strategy as described in the 2006 Region F Water Plan, including water provider agreements and system operations. Possible refinements to this strategy may be made to the water supplies in the Pecan Bayou watershed based on the results of an on-going Region F study in this watershed. Supplies for other surface water sources in Region F outside of the Pecan Bayou watershed will be identical to those used in the 2006 plan.

model (GAM) to help assess ground-water availability from the Gulf Coast aquifer in a five county area including all or parts of Goliad, Refugio, and Victoria Counties. Modeling was used to estimate the effects of variations in pumping rate from three potential wellfields for a 45-year period. Simulated drawdown was used to help assess potential mitigation and land subsidence issues.

- ***Lipan Aquifer Groundwater Availability Model, Texas*** – Collected and evaluated available hydrogeologic data from ground-water district and state databases. Developed a MODFLOW model to simulate groundwater availability from the upper alluvial aquifer and the lower Permian limestone aquifer. All model data was developed and evaluated within ArcGIS and was compatible/interchangeable with the modeling GUI. Aquifer water levels and streamflow data were used to calibrate and verify the steady state and transient models. The model incorporated stream-aquifer interaction as well as spatially and temporally varying recharge and pumping.

The model structure was based on site-specific borehole data, and calibrated to a multi-well long-term pump test and was consistent with the TWDB Trinity Aquifer GAM model within the modeled area. The model was used to assess affects of long-term pumping and multiple production scenarios.
- ***Ground-Water Availability Evaluation of Ogallala Aquifer, Andrews and Gaines Counties, Texas*** – Developed a MODFLOW ground-water availability model to predict the viability of producing large amounts of Ogallala ground water over a 25-year period from two proposed well fields for power generation cooling water. The regional model was calibrated and verified with "predevelopment" water levels and with water levels collected over a 50-year period. It accounted for past and future irrigation and municipal usage, incorporated heterogeneity in hydraulic properties, and paleo-channels that greatly influenced the ground-water availability.
- ***Evaluation of Ground-Water Availability for the Gulf Coast Aquifer, Texas*** – Utilized existing hydrogeologic evaluations, databases, and ground-water models in east Texas and the Coastal Bend area to develop availability estimates, sustainable yields, and long-term impacts from current and proposed ground-water usage.
- ***Update and Recalibration of Ground-Water Model for Reno, Nevada*** – Converted a complex, non-standard model to MODFLOW-96. The model implemented domestic and municipal pumping; distribution system leakage; recharge from mountain-fronts, precipitation, and irrigation; evapotranspiration; rivers and streams; and discharge from springs and man-made pits. The model will be used to complete wellhead protection assessment and evaluate long-term effects of multiple production scenarios. Data was developed within ArcView GIS and interchanged with ground-water model.
- ***Evaluation of Ground-Water Availability in the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer*** – Utilized existing MODFLOW ground-water flow model in northeast and central Texas to develop availability estimates and to determine the long-term impacts from projected ground-water demand. Evaluation helped identify potentially critical areas and aided in the development of a set of wells throughout the region to help assess future water-level changes.

visualization/animation techniques were used to effectively illustrate model results.

The ground water was contaminated with heavy metals and the constructed wetlands were designed to maintain a reducing environment for metals precipitation. The USGS code MODPATH was used to perform particle tracking through the wetlands area.
- **DOE WIPP Facility, Carlsbad, New Mexico** – Applied the SWIFT-II flow and transport model to investigate the transient pressure response of slanted well bores with the very low conductivity halite zones of the Salado Formation. 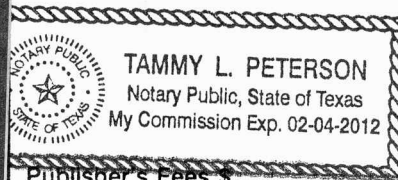

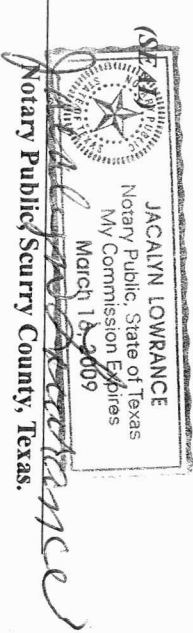

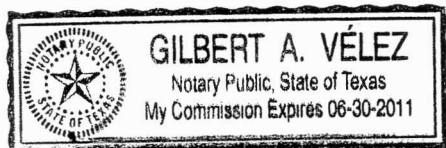
