Subject: Supporting information for HB 807 requirements

Good morning,

As mentioned in the House Bill (HB) 807 guidance provided in my 6/25/19 email, the TWDB is providing some supporting information for RWPGs to consider when addressing HB 807 requirements this cycle of regional water planning.

This email contains the following data to support setting gallons per capita daily (GPCD) goals and assessing aquifer storage and recovery (ASR) potential:

1. The *DB22_WUG_GPCD_Targets* workbook attached includes a list of municipal WUGs and associated planning GPCD data (2016 GPCD, baseline GPCD, and projected GPCD). This is an **optional** workbook for RWPGs to utilize in presenting GPCD goals in the regional water plans. Please see the workbook's read me tab for more information on the data provided. If your region chooses to utilize this workbook, please include the filled out electronic version with the regional water plan deliverables.
2. The *TWDB ASR Resources* document attached includes a list of TWDB's currently available and relevant information on ASR.

TWDB's Conservation staff is also compiling GPCD goal information from the 2019 water conservation plans. We anticipate GPCD information from these plans being available for your consideration in September.

Since you may be considering different sources of GPCD data, we are also providing an information sheet describing the methodologies to calculate GPCDs that are utilized in regional water planning and water conservation plans. This *GPCD Description for RWPGs* document is attached.
